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Update on Current Procedural Terminology Codes for Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Services for all Developmental Disabilities (DD) waivers

Corrected: March 1, 2019

The American Medical Association CPT® Editorial Panel has released eight new codes for billing ABA services (<https://webaba.com/2018/10/09/2019-aba-cpt-codes/>). These new codes went into effect on January 1, 2019. The new ABA assessment and treatment procedure codes combined some of the current 13 ABA waiver procedure codes and bill in 15-minute service units. The ABA DD waiver service definitions remain the same from the previous MO HealthNet Provider Bulletin dated March 2017. The conversion will be cost neutral and the limitations will be neutral.

The Division of Developmental Disabilities will submit waiver technical amendments for all Division of Developmental Disabilities four waivers to Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to align with the CPT code changes effective January 1, 2019.

The table below lists the new procedure codes, limits and Medicaid Maximum rates effective for dates of service on or after January 1, 2019. Modifiers for Comprehensive (HI); Community (U1); MOCDD (HA); Partnership for Hope (HX).

Billing/Authorization requirements

The Division is converting current authorizations to the new codes effective January 1, 2019. Waiver Services and Purchase of Services use the same CPT codes differentiated by the Service Category. Old CPT codes have been assigned December 31, 2018 end dates. New CPT codes and modifiers will be effective January 1, 2019. All new CPT codes should process in the same billing cycle without issue.

All of the new codes are 15-minute units. The new limitations and rates are equal to the previous limitations and rates at the different service unit size. The new codes eliminate the need for providers to bill a second unit/code for additional time on the same date.

The Division is currently in the process of updating contracts and service authorizations. The contracts with Behavior Service CPT codes and active authorizations were updated on December 12, 2018.
