
















### Received Mental Health Services in Past Year: U.S. and Missouri Ages 18 and Older






### Past-Month Use of Alcohol in the United States by Age

### Lifetime Use of Alcohol in the United States by Age








### Past-Month Use of Tobacco in the United States by Age

### Lifetime Use of Tobacco in the United States by Age








**Past-Month Use of Cigarettes in the United States by Age**

**Lifetime Use of Cigarettes in the United States by Age**








### Past-Month Use of Marijuana in the United States by Age

### Lifetime Use of Marijuana in the United States by Age








### Past-Month Use of Hallucinogens in the United States by Age

### Lifetime Use of Hallucinogens in the United States by Age








### Past-Month Use of Inhalants in the United States by Age

### Lifetime Use of Inhalants in the United States by Age








### Past-Month Use of Cocaine in the United States by Age






### Past-Month Use of Crack Cocaine in the United States by Age

### Lifetime Use of Crack Cocaine in the United States by Age








### Past-Month Use of Methamphetamine in the United States by Age

### Lifetime Use of Methamphetamine in the United States by Age












### Past-Month Use of Any Illicit Drug in the United States by Age
