The following update has been made to [Monitoring Guidance](#):

The Division of Developmental Disabilities is extending remote monitoring services* statewide and will remain in remote status through at least September 30, 2021, as Missouri is experiencing high levels of community transmission of COVID-19 throughout the state.

*To balance the health and welfare of individuals as well as reduce the footprint to manage COVID -19 spread, every person must be seen in-person once every three months while in remote monitoring status. The in-person visit can be an open air visit. Also, as a continued practice from previous remote monitoring status time periods, in-person visits will still be required for emergency situations or well checks due to noted concerns or requests from family/guardian.
