

University of Minnesota's Residential Information Systems Project

The <u>University of Minnesota's Residential Information Systems Project (RISP)</u> is funded by the Administration on Community Living as a Project of National Significance, National Longitudinal Study. The study began in 1977 and tracks Medicaid and state-funded long-term supports and services for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD). This annual survey of State IDD Agencies is fielded in collaboration with the Nation Association of State Directors of Developmental Disabilities Services (NASDDS). This survey is the basis for state and national profiles published in the annual RISP report.

The University of Minnesota has finished updating their website with FY 2018 data. A new <u>infographics section</u> features downloadable visuals highlighting key findings at a national level. The <u>interactive chart gallery</u> was also reformatted for easier access and features customizable graphs with both national and state level data.
