Missouri Partners in Policymaking is a leadership training program for adults with disabilities and parents of children with developmental disabilities. The program teaches leadership skills and techniques to develop positive partnerships with elected officials, school personnel and other individuals who make policy decisions about services used by people with developmental disabilities and their families.

Participants will be expected to make a commitment to attend all sessions, complete all homework assignments, and complete a major project designed to meet competencies. After learning leadership skills and advocacy techniques from state and national experts, participants go on to partner with policymakers to positively impact services for people with disabilities.
