Division of Developmental Disabilities

A continued Division priority is to provide timely updates to all stakeholders on the ConneXion Case Management System Implementation Project. ConneXion has a dedicated [webpage](#) with project information and updates. Project implementation is currently 88% complete. Contract amendment requirements were completed in January 2023. The Division and FEI Systems are in final stages of system and end-to-end testing of ConneXion. User Acceptance Testing will begin in February 2023, and end-user training preparation is under way.


CONNEXION GO-LIVE DATE

The project schedule has been revised to include the last set of contract amendments. To accommodate these amendments, the Go-live date has been moved to **July 17, 2023**.




CONNEXION DATA DIAGRAM

The Division has worked with FEI Systems to implement 10 interfaces with ConneXion to send and receive information and transfer data between CIMOR and ConneXion. This data transfer will populate the new system.



CONNEXION EDI COMPANION GUIDE

ConneXion will replace CIMOR **ALL** DD Waiver and Purchase of Service (POS) Billing. ConneXion will support electronic submission of claims and online data entry. Providers who currently bill electronically to CIMOR will need to make adjustments to be able to submit claims to ConneXion. The [ConneXion Companion Guide](#) for submitting electronic claims to the ConneXion system and the [ConneXion Claim Error Codes List](#) provide additional information about these changes. These documents should be reviewed by the provider billing system vendor. The diagram below outlines how the system will run through ConneXion at Go-live. Targeted Case Management providers will be required to document billable case notes in ConneXion. CONNEXION TRAINING UPDATE

The training plan and strategy have been completed. Training materials are in development. **End-user training will be required for all end-users of the ConneXion system, beginning in May 2023 and going through mid-July 2023.** ConneXion end-user training is system-based, focused on what users need to know day one and includes navigation and systematic workflows. In-person training will be held in Kansas City, Jefferson City, and St. Louis.
