DD Health Home Initial Provider Application

The Division of Developmental Disabilities (DD) is developing, in collaboration with the Missouri Department of Social Services, MO HealthNet Division, a new DD Health Home program.

DD Health Home is not a home; it is not a group home; and it is not in-home medical services. DD Health Home is an integrated model of care that provides comprehensive care coordination of medical, behavioral health, and other needed services for individuals with Intellectual and/or Developmental Disabilities (IDD) who have, or at risk of, chronic conditions.

This program will require a team of professionals to include a Health Home Director, Nurse Care Manager, Physician Consultant (Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) as a substitute), Specialized Healthcare Consultants and DD Health Home Facilitator. DD Health Home services are a state plan option, which is still pending approval by Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS); these services are provided statewide. A DD Health Home Provider will receive a Per Member Per Month (PMPM) for each individual enrolled in the DD Health Home. DD Health Home is not a direct fee-for-service or state plan service billing.

The Division will designate Targeted Case Management and accredited and/or certified Home and Community Based (HCBS) Waiver Providers as DD Health Home providers. Additional program requirements, including the DD Health Home Initial Provider Application, are available on the DD Health Home Webpage.

Completed applications will be accepted until close of business **12/15/23**. Please email the DD Health Home mailbox at DDHealthHome@dmh.mo.gov, and indicate in the subject line "DD HH Provider Application." Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
